CSA Opens Local Radio To National Networks

PARIS - French broadcasting authority the CSA has begun the new year with long-awaited good news for national operators, allowing them to increase their coverage through local stations.

The changes see the CSA relax the rules of its rigid category system by allowing "B" stations (local operators with local programming) to become "C" stations (local stations broadcasting a national programme), a switch which was previously banned.

The changes were motivated by the need to bring greater transparency to the French radio landscape and put an end to the "black market trading" of local frequencies.

The move—the brainchild of CSA member Philippe Labarde—has long been a demand of national operators, who claimed it was a key element in their plans for future development.

However, some radio operators have expressed regret that the decision was made without discussions with the country's representative radio groups.

According to the new CSA guidelines, delivered in what will now be known as "Communiqué 319", operators with a "B" authorisation who want to switch to "C" must hand back their licence. The station must then apply, together with the national network it has struck a deal with, for a "C" licence.

The CSA offers no guarantees that stations will automatically be granted a "C" licence, but it has said it will take into account an applicant's previous broadcasting history.

The communiqué also sees the CSA renewing its guidelines concerning shareholding of local radio stations. Under the new rules, the CSA cannot allow a national network—or anybody connected with one—to become shareholders in category B stations.

Media Bill Gives Digital Incentives

LONDON - Commercial radio broadcasters in the UK are to be offered uncontested eight-year extensions to their current analogue licences if they invest in DAB.

The "carrot" for both local and national stations to invest in digital is offered in a new Broadcasting Bill unveiled last month by the UK government, which hopes that private sector broadcasters will help the country lead the world in the development of digital broadcasting technology.

In the public sector, the BBC has already made substantial commitments to introducing the new technology.

German Radio Ad Spend Down In 1995

BONN - Germany's commercial radio stations recorded a 12.9% increase in advertising revenue over 1994,

but can expect much lower figures for 1995, according to recently-released statistics.

The figures, published by German advertising industry association ZAW, predict that 1995 advertising revenues will be half the value of those recorded in 1994. Kagan World Media expects a rise of only 5.7% to DM1.2 billion (app. US\$851 million) for this year.



Industry highlights this week

UNITED KINGDOM

Radio City Ditches Gold
Liverpool's Radio City has followed in the footsteps of its EMAP Radio neighbour Piccadilly Radio/Manchester by abandoning the gold format on its AM station, Radio City Gold. The new-look service will be re-badged Radio City 1548 AM, and will feature contemporary soft ACE and MOR hits alongside classic golden oldies from the '60s, '70s and '80s. Meanwhile, Piccadilly Radio is expected to complete the relaunch of Piccadilly Gold as Piccadilly 1152 AM when its new jingle package arrives later this month.

NETN Merges With Metro Traffic Control

The North East Travel Network (NETN) has been bought out by London-based Metro Traffic Control, and will operate as Metro Traffic's contractor for the north-east of England from offices in Middlesborough. The travel news service was set up by local broadcaster Les Gunn, who becomes Metro Traffic's regional operations manager.

Managerial Moves At EMAP

A number of top-level management changes have been made by EMAP Radio following its acquisition of the Metro Radio Group in September. Harry Dunne, former sales director at Radio Hallam/Sheffield, becomes MD at Metro Radio/Newcastle and TFM/Stockton. Red Rose Radio/Preston boss Dee Ford moves to the MD post at Radio Hallam and Viking Radio/Hull, in addition to overseeing Radio Aire/Leeds, whose current MD Peter McPharland will report to her. A similar arrangement will be in place in Cardiff, where Red Dragon Radio MD Peter Milburn will report to Kiss 100 FM/London MD Gordon McNamee.

Premier Radio Changes Format

London-based Christian station Premier Radio has seen changes to its "Promise of Performance" approved by the Radio Authority. The amount of music the station is allowed to play has been upped from 40% to 65%, although at least 40% must be drawn from categories described as "Christian easy listening" and "contemporary Christian worship." The station has recently hit severe financial problems (Music & Media, December 16) following a shortfall in advertising revenues and donations.

SPAIN

SER's Sports Show Tops The Polls

Cadena SER's midnight sports programme "El Languero" (The Crossbar) was voted the top radio sports show at the annual "football Oscars" ceremony in Madrid, in which a special jury of experts voted on the best radio and TV sports programmes. "El Languero" is presented by Jose Ramon de la Morena, and the award was accepted by SER director David Gavela. Days later, the latest EGM audience survey revealed that "EL Languero" is the most popular sports programme, with 1.5 million listeners.

SWEDEN

More Money To Swedish Commercial Radio

The amount of money spent on buying advertising space on Sweden's commercial radio stations increased by 48% in the first eight months of 1995, compared to the same period in 1994. In total, commercial stations took in around Skr167 million (app. US\$25.3 million) in the year to September. This means the stations, which were only legalised in 1993, now take 1.5% of the country's total advertising budget.

Gov't Considers Tax On Advertising

The Swedish government is currently considering introducing a tax for adverts on commercial radio and television stations. If the country's parliament passes the legislation, it is expected to come into effect in July. The proposal includes plans to charge a 6% tax on radio advertisements.

HOLLAND

PolyGram's Stable Profits

PolyGram has announced that its 1995 net profits—recorded in Dutch guilders—are likely to be stable when compared to 1994, but up in local currency terms. Since 1990, PolyGram has achieved an annual growth rate of around 13% in net sales and 20% in net income. However, the company says that in 1995 its results will have been affected by a weaker-than-normal performance from its second-half release schedule, a delay in the delivery of certain important albums, the absence of a major hit from its film division and a strong appreciation in the value of the guilder. The company's 1996 release schedule includes new albums from Bryan Adams, The Cranberries, Sheryl Crow and U2.

Atlantic 252 Registers First Ever Profit Figures

DUBLIN - Atlantic 252 has recorded its first operating profit since it was set up in 1987, with earnings of close to US\$2 million for the first six months of 1995.

The station's operating company, Radio Tara, is based in Trim, County Meath, Ireland, and broadcasts as Atlantic 252 on a longwave signal. It is jointly owned by Irish pubcaster, RTE and CLT. Since it first began operating eight years ago, Atlantic 252 has become the largest commercial radio station in Britain.

Interim figures for 1995 show the company earned an operating profit of US\$1.7 million in the first six months of the year up to June 1995, compared with a loss of US\$130,000 for the same period in 1994.

The station's revenue for the six-month period was US\$4.74

Lotti Breaks Belgian Records

BRUSSELS - Flemish singer Helmut Lotti's switch to the classics has been rewarded with a number of firsts in the Belgian music industry.

Lotti began his career in 1990 propelled by the boom in Flemish music following the launch of the region's commercial TV station VTM. Since then he has been a constant figure in the charts.

In September this year, Lotti took over the 55-strong Golden Symphony Orchestra at

the Antwerp Queen Elizabeth Hall for two shows. Personal renditions of 18 classic songs from *O Sole Mio* to *Granada* were recorded for audio and video release.

The album *Helmut Lotti Goes Classic* (BMG Ariola) was released on November 13 and within a month sold over 200,000 copies—a new feat in the Belgian music industry. Lotti has also topped the international album pop and classical charts, leaving behind stars like Queen and Madonna.

The video of the concert was premiered on BRTN TV on December 8 and sold 5,000 copies in three days, while a 25,000-seater concert tour sold out one month in advance.

million compared with US\$2.68 million in the first six months of 1994 and net profit for the period amounted to US\$1.58 million compared to a net loss of US\$341,182 in 1994.

"The investment required over the past number of years to establish a strong and successful business in Ireland is now bearing fruit," Radio Tara chairman Donnach O'Driscoll told Music & Media. "We now employ 30 people and contribute IR£1.75 million (app. US\$2.76 million) to the Irish economy annually."

He says RTE and CLT had invested almost IR£20 million since the company was set up as a joint venture in 1987 to make it the largest and one of the most

successful commercial radio stations in Britain.

"The Board is confident that this performance can be built on," he says, "realising an increased profit for the full year and maintaining the strong contribution to the local and national communities."

Atlantic 252 was thrust into the news last month when Ireland's Independent Radio and Television Commission (IRTC) unveiled proposals to withdraw the station's licence and replace it with a service aimed at the Irish population in Europe.

Radio Tara, however, rejected the plans, which were part of a response to the government's green paper on broadcasting.

Tina's Tour: The Full Story

Gov't Proposals 'Ignore' Radio

COPENHAGEN - The Danish culture ministry has revealed its recommendations for the future of the country's media landscape, but no concrete decision is expected to be taken for around a year.

Radio representatives are angered that the proposals almost entirely ignore the medium, with the few radio-related suggestions open to individual interpretation.

The ministry has established a committee to examine means of restructuring and strengthening national, regional and local media. The committee will draw up a bill by April 1996, with legislation expected to be passed in the autumn.

The ministry recommends extended broadcasting coverage,

but in the form of more stations with added power.

Public stations will get access to new DAB technology, which will be funded through state money. Politicians will debate and decide upon who will get P4, a country-wide FM channel.

KOMM, the association of commercial TV/radio, says that the government's latest move is a strategy to buy time.

The organisation's vice chairman Steen Soedergreen is not optimistic about the government proposals. "Radio is apparently a small thing that must be dealt with. Radio stations will be allowed to network local news programmes. But the term 'local' has not been defined. If it means strictly local in the same sense as a local station, then there would be no sense in networking."

GERMANY

On Air Offers German Beatle Years

Berlin-based syndicator On Air is offering stations a new edition of its German-language version of the radio series "The Beatle Years". Co-produced by Westwood One, the series features exclusive interviews from John Lennon's private archives as well as private conversations and rare live tracks from the band. The series is aired by eight German stations including Antenne Bayern, NDR 2, HR 3, SFB B2 and Energy Sachsen. On Air is scheduled to release the programme in other languages next year.

Echo 1996 Doubles Audience Figures

For the first time in the five-year history of the German Echo awards, the general public has been invited to join the awards show. The event will take place on February 23 at the CCH Congress Centre in Hamburg. In addition to the 1,500 seats in the stalls reserved for industry representatives, another 1,500 circle seats will be available to the public. Ranging from DM35-55 (app. US\$24-37), tickets for the public are priced considerably lower than industry attendant's tickets. As in previous years, the fee for industry representatives will include a charity donation and admission to the after-show party.

MDR Plans New Satellite Channel

Leipzig-based pubcaster MDR plans to split its cultural channel MDR Kultur into separate talk and classical music programmes. MDR director radio Karola Sommerer hopes to create a new satellite-only station MDR Concert to provide an outlet dedicated to classical music. Sommerer proposes to turn the original MDR Kultur into a talk format station and rename it Radio Phönix.

UNITED KINGDOM

Music Show Sold Around The World

Tribute Management has announced that its "Greatest Music Party In The World", scheduled for December 13-17, is to be aired by broadcasters around the world, including a prime slot on BBC 1 TV channel on Christmas day. Held at Birmingham's NEC venue, the show has so far been sold to

40 international broadcasters, a company spokesman says, with the event featuring 24 acts including David Bowie, Rod Stewart, East 17, Eternal and Diana Ross.

RAB Predicts Strong Growth In Advertising

The Radio Advertising Bureau (RAB) is expecting commercial radio to have made 15% more revenue in the last quarter of the year than during the same 1994 period. The RAB further claims that radio has secured increases throughout the year averaging more than 20%.

Radio 4 Wins Radio Journalism Award

BBC Radio 4's current affairs programme "Face The Facts" has won the overall award and also the radio category in the Industrial Society's Industrial Journalism Awards.

GWR Profits Up 71%

The GWR Group has reported annual pre-tax profits of £5.3 million for the year ending September 30—an increase of 71% on last year. The Group now operates 28 UK local licences, including the Chiltern Radio Network stations which were purchased in August. Chairman Henry Meakin comments, "We intend to apply for the UK regional licences which have begun to be advertised. The current year has started well, with revenues ahead of expectations, and the board anticipates further success in the years ahead."

SPAIN

Cadena 100 Sings Along With Bruce

Cadena 100 has given away thousands of booklets with the lyrics in English and Spanish of Bruce Springsteen's new album, *The Ghost of Tom Joad*. The booklet was included for one day in copies of the national daily *Diario 16*.

FINLAND

Pubcaster YLE Examines 1996 Budget

Finland's pubcaster YLE is in the process of approving a new budget for next year. The company has assumed its revenues will grow again in 1996, both through the increased purchase of TV licences and through a higher contribution from the commercial operator MTV3. Next year's budget is said to include increases in training and development projects aimed at keeping the company's programming competitive.

Ex-RAI Host Luca De Gennaro Moves To MTV

MILAN - Ex-RAI presenter Luca De Gennaro has been appointed artistic director at MTV Italy, where he will be responsible

for compiling the playlist used in Italian language opt-outs which currently run between 14:00-15:45 and 17:30-18:00 daily.

Europe is relayed terrestrially in Italy 13 hours daily (13:00-19:00 and 24:00-07:00) on the Telepiù 3 national network. Italian language output is expected to increase early next year.

MTV Italy director Sebastiano Mussini says the possible increase of Italian programming will depend on the


results of research being conducted at the moment. "We have a series of focus groups with viewers giving us feedback on what they think of the existing programming and

what they would like to see in the future."

De Gennaro leaves the Rome-based satellite TV broadcaster "Orbit Satellite TV & Radio Network," where he was artistic director for the Music No! channel,

which is part of a 22-channel encrypted package beamed to Arabic populations in North Africa and the Middle East.

De Gennaro, who will take up his new post at MTV Italy next February, has also been a regular presenter on Italian pubcaster RAI Radio 2's late

News/Talk Nets Rise In Ratings

MADRID - News/talk Cadena SER set a new audience record with nearly 4.2 million listeners, according to the Estudio General de Medios (EGM) survey for October-November.

The survey, which also showed Cadena COPE's ACE/rock net Cadena 100 creeping towards the one million mark, revealed that the majority of news/talk and music nets increased their audience during this period, with Cadena SER again dominating both formats.

News/talk SER's record 4.166.000 audience was mirrored by SER's EHR Los 40 Principales 2.960.000—both an increase on the respective 4.078.000 and 2.839.000 in the April-May survey. It is only the second time that news/talk SER has broken the 4 million mark.

When former Los 40 director Rafael Revert moved to COPE to set up Cadena 100 three years ago, he counted on reaching the million target within five years. The ACE/rock Cadena 100 comes out with a daily audience of 951.000, up from 945.000 in

April-May, and 691.000 this time last year. "The figures are excellent—not just for Cadena 100, but for Spanish radio at the moment," comments Revert.

Of the 20.4 million daily listeners, 14.1 million tune into news/talk nets, which constitutes a rise of 5% over the previous survey. Behind news/talk SER, Cadena COPE has closed the gap with 3.560.000 listeners (up from 3.382.000,) while third-placed Onda Cero Radio has dropped slightly to 2.639.000 from 2.768.000. RNE's Radio 1 is up to 2.179.000 from 2.120.000.

The second most popular music net, SER's all-Spanish Cadena Dial, set its own personal record with 1.760.000 listeners, up 105.000 on the previous survey. SER's ACE/oldies M-80 stayed in fourth place but lost ground at 545.000 listeners compared to 603.000. Cadena top Radio rose to 416.000 listeners.

A mini battle for the classical music audience is emerging, meanwhile, with RNE veteran Radio Clásica recording 155.000 listeners against SER's 18-month old Sinfo Radio's 110.000.

My agenda is always bursting with appointments before I get down to Cannes. Hotel lobbies, especially at the Majestic or the Carlton, are good spots to sit down and talk business. For more relaxed meetings I prefer a good restaurant like L'Oasis or the Colombe D'Or. If you like rustic dishes from the Provence, La Mer Besson in Cannes is a real find. I would recommend every MIDEM freshman they make as many appointments ahead as they can. Otherwise you might find they people you want to talk to are booked up and rushed off their feet. Also, set aside two to three days in your schedule for a post-MIDEM analysis of your meetings and all the material you collected during the event."



Brunet Steers Europe 1 To Its Roots

PROGRAMMING

After 40 years on air, French full-service net Europe 1 has dropped from its position as '60s taste-maker to the fifth most popular net in France. It is time for serious measures, but can the net regain a lost leadership in today's radio market?

For year's the station's management acted as if nothing was wrong. Advertising revenues were not affected and the image of the station remained good, despite aging listeners and ratings which had been steadily dropping since the early '80s.

But the autumn 1994 schedule was widely tipped as "schizophrenic" by analysts wondering how the station could balance its 25-45 programming with the absurdist comedy of "Les Nuls", or "Arthur Et Les Pirates," targeted at under 25s.

After a period of reported unrest among both management and journalists, last spring's Médiamétrie ratings put Europe 1 in fifth place, behind RTL, France Inter, NRJ and France Info. This was a sharp contrast with its glory pre-1981 days, when it was the leading station ahead of RTL.

This, coupled with the news that the station had dropped below a 10% national share, led to the decision that it was time to act.

Station president Jacques Lehn, under pressure from Europe 1's parent company Matra Hachette, decided to introduce radical sweeps. This began with the ousting of programme director Patrice Blanc-Francard followed by news director Jean-Pierre Joulin, and led to the arrival of a new triumvirate to manage the station: Denis Jeambar as scheduling director, Gilles Schneider as news director, and Claude Brunet as programme director.

Both the philosophy and the schedule of the station were overhauled, from targeting the "elite," to "addressing the widest audience possible" in Lehn's words.

Jeambar and Schneider restructured the news division, with the aim of making the station "the outlet that breaks the news," while the entertainment and variety shows were similarly reshaped. "Les Nuls" was dropped, "Arthur" was shortened, and shows were redesigned to be more listener-friendly, according to Brunet in an interview with Music & Media.

"Our job is now to reformat this station as a full-service station targeted at the over-30s." But, he stresses, the changes are now supported by a concerted effort. "This is real teamwork. We function as a coherent trio. There is no barrier between information and entertainment."

One of the criticisms most often made about the Europe 1 schedule was that it had lost its soul and its roots. A criticism Brunet and his colleagues have set out to redress. Along with Jeambar and Schneider one of his prior-

ities has been to find the station's identity—while keeping the sound in the '90s.

"We tried to return to the fundamentals of Europe 1—both in terms of news and entertainment, which have been built to be as homogenous as possible," says Brunet. "News has been honed down to be concise, precise, offering the facts and comments. And the rest of the schedule is coherent with the general background of Europe 1."

Europe 1's ambition is to become a full-service station, but on FM rather than AM, he explains. "The original audience of the AM nets is decreasing and aging, while new listeners are growing up with the FM band. We have to fit in the new picture without surrendering our nature."

One of the main changes will be an emphasis on an over-30s female audience, as opposed to the over-45 male audience which they had been targeting.

"We want to offer over-30s audiences a product they can't find elsewhere," says Brunet, indicating a departure from the former policy of niche programming different parts of the day to catch the widest possible audience.

"One thing is certain in radio, and that is that if you court new listeners without comforting your existing listeners, you face losing both.

"We have to inform and entertain our audience with the maximum interactivity. Rather than reducing Europe 1 to a single format, our job is to find the right balance between the various elements that create the brand Europe 1. I don't think the concept of the full-service station is outdated or about to disappear, but it is in a state of inescapable mutation."

One of the symbolic shows of this new policy is the 20:00-22:00 programme called "Generations Europe 1," hosted by Michel Field, which mixes news, entertainment and calls from listeners. "My tendency is to go for a programme that speaks to its listeners."

Brunet, who reports to Jeambar, has grown up in the radio and the music industry. After a spell at Europe 1 in the '70s, he moved to work for RCA, which became BMG, and then to indie label Tréma. Until his appointment at Europe 1, he served as consultant for the group's international arm Europe Développement.

"To be honest I prefer building things rather than modifying them," he says. "But in the case of Europe 1, I guess I am attached to this station and I have a passion for radio. Sometimes in life you do things that are not motivated by career plans, but because they come to you.

"This company has something very special, and being back here is an excit-

de la Croix's "Classics Of Tomorrow" on Sunday afternoons. "The generation which grew up after the war was marked by the arrival of rock n' roll. Their life has been marked by key musical moments, while the new generation is more TV-oriented and has grown up with FM musical networks," says Brunet.

"We can't expect our audience to be schizophrenic, so it's up to us to build and offer a musical policy that takes into account this diversity and richness."

The key is to balance gold titles—principally the '60s and the '70s—with new releases, believes Brunet, who hopes Europe 1 will regain the status of trend-setting radio.

"Even if we don't have the strength we had in the '60s, when the station had the power to break new acts, I'd like Europe 1 to be an alternative to the very tightly-formatted programming of the FM nets and be the place where listeners can discover new music."

Links with record companies are managed on two levels: the day-to-day programming and contact, which is handled by Brunet along with four programmers, and special operations, which are supervised by Jean Isnard.


"It is important that promotion and programming are han-

dled as two separate fields," says Brunet. "Our relationship with record companies is good. They understand what we are trying to do and I am convinced that on some artists, we can be the trend setters."

Like the other full-service stations, Europe 1 does not use high rotation policies or automatic programming. Music programmers have a lot of flexibility in their choices, although the balance between golds and new releases is important.

French-produced music continues to form the backbone of programming. "Way over the quota requirements. All in all, the combination is the kind of music you would expect over-'30s to listen to—which means that you will rarely hear techno on Europe 1!"

Brunet concludes, "Our initial goal is to stabilise the audience, then gain on some demos such as women, and overall, gain in audience. It will take time and we have to be modest—something Europe 1 has not always been used to."

ing challenge. The real question now is will we be able to replace the station in today's environment? I think that if the station had started earlier to look around at the world outside it, we wouldn't have to have been called in."

As far as music is concerned, Europe 1 will continue to play a large spectrum, from chanson, to rock, rap, blues, and jazz. But with an emphasis on balance between styles and time slots.

Despite a high profile in the industry, "Top Live", the expensive live music show hosted by Marc Toesca has been cut from once a day to once a week—now appearing on Sunday evenings. Toesca also hosts chart show "Le Top" on Saturdays, based on music industry official charts.

Other specific musical shows include "Vinyl Fraise" (Vinyl Strawberry) every afternoon, which profiles popular music from the '50s to the '90s, or the Saturday night "Musicorama," during which Bluesman Patrick Verbeke explores the world of blues, and Philip



N-Trance Album Shows More Than Bee Gees Fans

MANCHESTER - When 1994 drew to a close, Manchester dance act N-Trance had made a respectable debut, scoring two Top 40 singles in the UK and winning a strong following in the north of England and Scotland. Since then they have become international stars. The single *Set You Free* was one of the UK's biggest sellers of the year and the follow-up *Stayin' Alive* has enjoyed considerable chart success. It peaked at number 3 in the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles and reached number 10 in the EHR Top 40. Last month N-Trance released their debut album *Electronic Pleasure*; its title track will be released as a single this month.

"The album is full of song-based material", says **Matt Cadman**, label manager of independent **All Around The World**, who signed the duo in late 1993 after their previous, unsuccessful relationship with 380 Records came to an end. "The album is quite diverse. They're not afraid to use guitars where guitars are right, and there are ballads on it as well." The lack of a set formula is evident in the singles so far. "*Set You Free* was a 140 bpm breakbeat tune from the old school of rave and *Stayin' Alive* has rap in it," says Cadman. "The new single *Electronic Pleasure* is no bubblegum Euro-dance, but a bit harder. The band just go in their own direction."

Set You Free sold well over half a million copies in the UK and its success helped pave the way for the band's export to the rest of Europe. London-

based company **General Overseas** look after the international licensing and marketing of N-Trance. Managing director **Bob Cunningham** confirms that "After *Set You Free* was a hit here, it definitely broke some ground in Europe and made people aware of the band. When *Stayin' Alive* came along, it was the icing on the cake. It went very quickly everywhere. For instance, in France it normally takes months for a record to break, but this one just went in about three weeks. We had done an international club mailing on it, which created an instant buzz. Also, it was the right time at the end of the summer."

Dance albums are notoriously more difficult to market than singles, but Cunningham says General Overseas has had a good response to the album from licensees. "We basically fed the album deals on the back of the singles. There are three or four more tracks off the album which should sell that album."

Label manager of **Dance Pool France** **Olivier Chatelin** elaborates on the French success. "NRJ Network liked it very much from the beginning and played it five times a day. Also, it was number 1 in the clubs two weeks after its release." He thinks the amusing '70s style video and an

emerging disco revival in France have all helped N-Trance have the fastest dance hit he has ever worked on; it reached number 4 just three weeks after its release. Major French TV stations have booked N-Trance for January and Chatelin expects a second wave of interest in the record then



and *Turn Up The Power*. Head of music **David Dunne** explains, "N-Trance know dance music but they're also pop music fans. They're an ideal group for us because during the day we're quite commercial, but the vital thing is that they're local. We were playing their stuff from the start and because we got behind them so much they've supported us. They were number 1 all over Europe this last year and they still found time to come in and give us the world exclusive on *Stayin' Alive*."

"*Set You Free* was very difficult for airplay", says Cadman, explaining the caution elsewhere. "People don't feel they can programme something that is 140 bpm breakbeat. It does present a problem for programmers, and in particular for ILR stations, because they have a safer music policy. Radio One reluctantly put

it on the B-list once it was number 2. *Stayin' Alive* on the other hand finally made it to Radio One's A-list. Radio One really championed the cause for *Stayin' Alive* because it was a good pop record and the ILR's followed suit."

As Cunningham confirms "It's a radio record," accounting for the international success of *Stayin' Alive*, "and it's being proved in the US, where it has just been released and there are radio stations calling for it."

Cast Can Build On Costello And Entwistle

LIVERPOOL - Four Scouse lads have played their way into the hearts of pop legends Elvis Costello and John Entwistle over the past three years. Cast is still very much a musician's band, but the general public is beginning to pay attention to their brand of classic English rock music.

Polydor UK A&R director **Paul Adam** sees the songwriting skills of ex-La's bassman John Power as Cast's biggest asset. "This man's on a mission. After he left the La's, he had time to realise his own potential." Sensitive, honest and proud, Cast's lyrics strut along—while the instrumentals growl and purr like a trusty BSA motorbike.

Cast have toured the UK without a break for the past three years, during which they received little A&R attention. It was left to fellow artists to declare their potential. Elvis Costello asked the band to open his show on a recent UK tour, and The Who's bass player John Entwistle invited them into his private

home studio to record some tracks. Entwistle did not actually play with the band, according to Cast lead guitarist **Liam 'Skin' Tyson**. "But later that night, we got him drunk and made him play the bass for us. It was brilliant."

Adam reveals that some of the tracks recorded that evening will surface as B-sides of the following two

are available on their debut album *All Change* we will couple them with some unreleased tracks."

BBC's regional London station **GLR** has been playing both tracks already since October. Head of music **Jon Myer** explains, "We played not only *Sandstorm* and *Walkaway* straight from the album, but also picked *Two Of A Kind* from the album because they are snappy, short pop songs."

The band's Polydor signing was prompted by a lucky accident. Adam knew Power from the time he handled the La's as a booking agent at ITB in 1990-91. Four years later as A&R director at Polydor, Adam caught up accidentally with Power and his new outfit. "I saw Cast for the first time supporting Shed Seven which I just had signed. My first thought was 'God, they are good', he says. "If they carry on like that they'll blow my boys off the stage." Adam ended up signing the band a few months later.

"Ever since the La's, I have admired John as a songwriter and I love their harmonies," he explains. "I signed Cast

because of the way they execute these songs on stage, full of determination and energy."

The lads are thrilled to be signed to the label which used to be the home of The Who, a band which figures prominently in the collective mind of the band. Money is tight in Liverpool and musical tastes are often determined by sheer availability or chance meetings. In a city with a buoyant dance club scene Tyson grew up with Pete Townshend's classic guitar riffs as a soundtrack for everyday life. "I've been playing the guitar since I was six," says Tyson. "*Can You Feel The Real Me* on *Quadrophenia*, that's the first song I remember. My uncle taped it for me one Christmas. From then on, it was Townshend who got me into the electric guitar. I love the power of it."

Cast is getting restless to follow up their debut. "We need some time off now. You can't write when you're on tour," says Tyson. "All the songs on *All Change* were written 2-3 years ago. We're doing one more European tour in February '96, and then we'll get down to work on our next album."

Adam thinks he can get the lads into the studio in April and May. "John played me some loose sketches on an acoustic guitar," says Adam. "They're classics. He's a timeless writer."

 An Israeli singer/songwriter who lives in New Jersey and has based an entire album on existing poems; it sounds a little farfetched, but this album isn't. All elements are united by the unescapable intensity of Broza's vocals and the tightness of his band. He has found his own kind of bluesy R&R which is particularly catchy on *O Captain! My Captain*, based on a Walt Whitman poem the kind of song Melissa Etheridge would kill for. *Yesterday's News* is a catchy blues song.

 Fascinating new material, written especially for the film score of the upcoming "Dead Man Walking" by a star-studded ensemble. Springsteen's contribution is very much in the vein of *The Ghost Of Tom Joad*. Johnny Cash also sticks to his guns in *In My Mind*. Songs inspired by the execution of a death row convict are not likely to be very cheerful, but Suzanne Vega and Patti Smith have delivered particularly chilling contributions. Truly innovative is the coupling of Eddie Vedder and Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan, probably an idea of producer Ry Cooder. Vedder's vocal restraint and his delicate composition *The Long Road* are full of promise for the new Pearl Jam album, to be released later this year.

■ Rumours abound that top US stadium rock band **Journey** is reforming. The new line-up includes singer **Steve Perry**, guitarist **Neal Schon**, bass player **Ross Valory**, keyboardist **Jonathan Cain** and drummer **Steve Smith**.



■ **Needle Mythology** will be the next single from **Stephen Duffy** on **Indolent/RCA**. It is the third release lifted off his label debut *Duffy* and its January 29

release could coincide with a tour.



Breakin' & Entering

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Ramon Dahmen

To ensure continuation in the sales chart, Music & Media is publishing the last chart of 1995 in this first issue of 1996. Issue 2 will contain the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles and European Top 100 Albums of week 1 and 2. In that week there will be no Breaking & Entering column, or A-Z.

In the last week of 1995 neither the European Top 100 Albums nor the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles showed a change in their number one positions. Although both platinum acts at the pole position have lost their bullets, they still hold an edge over the runners-up. The number one single **Coolio feat. LV** even keeps its strong chart positions (all top 2) in twelve of the thirteen countries where charted, only losing strength in the UK where it drops from number 9 to 14.



The overriding winner of both Sales Breaker Awards is **Michael Jackson**, with *Earth Song* (Epic) on the singles side and *History - Past Present & Future Book 1* (Epic) on the albums front. With his album Jackson entered the chart in issue 26 and peaked for the first time one week later at number 1. With already 27 weeks on chart *History...* is still selling itself into the charts in Austria (no.10), Belgium (19), Denmark (9), Finland (27), France (6), Germany (3), Ireland (13), Holland (21), Norway (18), Portugal (27), Sweden (33), Switzerland (3) and the UK (8). Jackson's plaintive for the environment on *Earth Song*, the last release from the album, can be heard in thirteen of the sixteen countries contributing to the Eurochart. Besides the top 10 positions on page 11, the record charts in Italy (no.13) and Sweden (12).

The highest new entry in the Hot 100 Singles is **Queen** with Freddie Mercury's last composition *A Winter's Tale* (Parlophone). As a newcomer in five national countdowns, the single is positioned outside the top 10 in Germany (88), Ireland (41), Holland (32) and Hungary (17).

Only seven Christmas releases can be found in the year's last singles and albums chart: **Kelly Family** with *Christmas For All*, **Kyrkjebø/Domingo/Aznavour** *Christmas in Vienna* and **Barbara Hendricks's** *Christmas Songs* in the album chart, and **Queen's** *A Winter's Tale*, **Childliners's** *The Gift Of Christmas*, **Whigfield** with her double A sided *Last Christmas/Big Time* and **Worlds Apart** with *When It's Christmas*.

The government has also decided that the previously-unallocated seventh (digital) multiplex should be awarded to local commercial radio, removing the fears of some operators that there would not be enough space for them to broadcast on DAB (Music & Media, November 4).

However, there could still be problems in London, where, even with an extra multiplex devoted to local radio, the current number of stations outstrips the number of DAB frequencies available.

The Broadcasting Bill, which is expected to become law by July, will scrap the numerical limit (currently 35) of local radio licences which any one company

can hold. Instead, companies will be restricted to a 15% share of the total number of radio "points" available—a system which takes into account the population size and waveband for each licence held.

The change in regulations will enable one or two big radio groups—most notably Capital—to expand further, which could well lead to another bout of takeover activity within the industry.

The government has resisted pressure, however, from the Association of Independent Radio Contractors (AIRC) to allow one company to operate more than one FM licence in a single market. The change had been opposed by the Radio Authority, which felt such a move would be damaging to plurality.

Industry reaction to the bill is slightly mixed, but on the whole supportive. Virgin Radio chief executive David Campbell describes it as "very positive," and is delighted that his national station will not now have to

participate in a "highest cash bidder" auction to retain its licence. He adds that Virgin is already making plans to broadcast on DAB, starting with a test broadcast in London during the early part of the year.

MD of EMAP Radio Tim Schoonmaker agrees the bill is a "step forward" in creating a more flexible set of regulations, and he welcomes the powers given to the Secretary of State to make changes to the Broadcasting Act by order. "It means that it [the legislation] can breathe and move as the industry develops, and won't become obsolete in six month's time."

"For the first time, the 1994 figures include all private broadcasters in Germany," says ZAW spokesman Thomas Docter. "The record gain in 1994 is mainly due to the addition of the 23 large private stations represented by Hamburg-based sales house RMS."

The ZAW statutes do not allow for commercial companies to become members. "RMS had to form a non-profit affiliate first before joining us," explains Docter.

The 1994 statistics show a drop in revenues for all publishers except Radio Bremen and ORB, while commercial broadcasters improved their

ad sales, meaning that for the first time private stations can officially claim more advertising income than the public. Commercial broadcasters account for 57% of the DM1.1 billion total ad revenues in 1994, according to the ZAW.

However, the federation of German private broadcasters VPRT says the advertising market has been fairly stable over the past three years.

Spokesman Dr. Stötzl says, "Private radio has had more than a 50% share in the total radio advertising market since around 1992." He explains the belated rise in economic performance of private radio by pointing to the addition of the RMS-represented stations to the statistics.

Rumoured This Week...

SLM's Kühn To Challenge Media Amendments In Court

Saxony's media authority SLM seems doomed to an uncertain future after the state parliament approved changes in the media law. Amendments suggested by ruling conservative party CDU will put the state's prime minister in control of the development of Saxony's radio landscape. Prime minister Kurt Biedenkopf is a renown critic of the public broadcasting system. He is rumoured to be entertaining plans to weaken the market position of Saxony pubcaster MDR. Music & Media also hears that SLM director Detlef Kühn plans to file an injunction against the amendments with the German constitutional court in Karlsruhe.

Columbia Goes Bananas

Sony Music Holland is said to have hired Bananas Studios-owner Dan van Rijsbergen as general manager for its recently-formed Columbia division. Together with Sony Music's marketing manager Gerard Rutte who will head the Epic division, Van Rijsbergen will report directly to Sony Music MD Paul Hertog. Columbia's alternative rock roster should already be familiar to Van Rijsbergen, who recently produced the debut album of Dutch grunge rockers' Van Dik Hout.

IFPI To Issue Pan-European Awards

Music & Media hears that the IFPI in London is working on the implementation of official pan-European sales awards—gold for 500,000 copies sold and platinum for one million, the same classifications in use at Music & Media. The news is likely to be made official at MIDEM 1996.

The CSA says the changes in its category system were motivated by a 1994 broadcasting law, which allows one single company to operate a number of networks as long as its potential reach doesn't exceed 150 million listeners.

In addition, the authority says the changes were the only realistic way to allow national networks to develop legally, although in the past some operators had acquired local stations without the CSA's approval.

Summarising the view of

many in the industry, ACE Europe 2 general manager Yves Taieb says, "It was a logical and legal step that was anticipated by us. Today the CSA is taking into consideration the philosophy and the spirit of the 1994 Communications Law, which gives us the means to really develop."

The move was also welcomed by the independent radio operators' group SIRTI which says, "If these measures are implemented with strength and wisdom, they could not only slow down independent station's shrinking space, but also reverse the trend."

Airplay Action

EHR Top 40 commentary by Pieter Kops

The new year starts with a new number 1 song on European Hit Radio. Michael Jackson's *Earth Song* enjoys a slight advantage in chart points over Tina Turner's *GoldenEye*, which now steps back one notch after a two-week reign on the format. *Earth Song* is the sixth EHR number 1 for Jackson—his previous triumphs include 1991's *Black Or White* (eight weeks at the top slot, lasting into 1992), 1992's *Remember The Time* (four weeks), 1993's *Give In To Me* (one week) and last year's *Scream* (featuring his sister Janet, five weeks) and *You Are Not Alone* (four weeks).

Jackson's new single is reported by 111 EHR stations in 25 countries throughout Europe. Especially in Switzerland and Austria, it is getting massive support (100% airplay penetration), while Denmark (93%) and the UK (81%) form the second league.

Simply Red continues its chart ascension in Radio Active form for the second consecutive week, gaining new playlist activity in 11 countries, notably Poland, Switzerland and Holland. The total EHR roster of *Remembering The First Time* now measures 89 stations, encompassing 21 European territories—the UK, Ireland, Austria and Poland are taking the lead.

The highest new entry in the EHR Top 40, at number 27, goes to Queen. *A Winter's Tale*, the follow-up to *Heaven For Everyone* (still charting at 14) and the second single from the current European Top 100 Albums number 1, *Made In Heaven*, has collected a 50-station roster, comprising of 35 new adds, earning it the additional status of Most Added leader. As yet, the record is being reported by programmers in 14 countries, doing best on the British and the Polish airwaves. *A Winter's Tale* is Queen's seventh EHR hit—two of these hit the top spot—*Somebody To Love* (with George Michael) reigned for one week in 1993 and *Heaven For Everyone* held the pole position for three weeks last year.

Coincidentally, George Michael's new single also enters the EHR run-down this week—as second highest new entry at number 30. The single, due for release on January 8, is Michael's label debut for Virgin, anticipating an as yet untitled album, due out in March. *Jesus To A Child*, a monumental ballad as only Michael can write them, was already premiered at the MTV Europe Music Awards in Berlin in 1994. The artist enjoyed six EHR hits before, three of them hitting the top spot—apart from the collaboration with Queen, mentioned above, these were 1991's *Freedom* (three weeks at number 1) and 1992's *Toofunky* (two weeks). The new single encounters best initial support in the UK, Germany, Austria and Norway.


