Victoires Awards To Reform

PARIS - The structure of French music awards organisation Association des Victoires de la Musique is to change following criticisms of the 1996 awards.

The major change is a split between the function of general manager of the Association and the producer of the awards show—previously, both jobs were handled by Claude Fléouter, founder of the Victoires ten years ago and producer of the TV show through his company Téléscope Audiovisuel.

The controversy which precipitated the need for changes concerned Fléouter's partner

EMI Buys Into Radio As GWR Move On Classic FM

LONDON - The freshly-demerged EMI Group has taken a 10% stake in a newly enlarged GWR Group, which has purchased Classic FM to create what it hopes will be a major force in international radio.

EMI finance director Simon Duffy explains, "EMI, along with other music companies, recognises the obvious power of music radio—and TV—in developing music markets locally. There are some places where music radio, and consequently the music business, is underdeveloped, and there could well be opportunities [for EMI] to help stimulate [non-UK] music markets by supporting the establish-

ment and growth of good local radio. We are not in the radio business," he continues, "but we do understand music markets. GWR, on the other hand, has a good track record in radio management."

Duffy predicts that the combination of GWR and EMI will bring increasingly important benefits for EMI in the future. "It won't be immediate," he admits, "but sooner or later GWR will run out of growth opportunities in the UK. They'll be looking overseas—as they have to some extent already done. As and when that happens, EMI will be involved with GWR in finding opportunities to create and develop good local music radio stations overseas. It's not so much a strategic 'desire' on

EMI's part to be involved in the radio business, as an investment in the future growth of EMI's music business overseas."

As was widely anticipated, GWR took the opportunity presented by Time Warner's decision to sell its 32.7% share in Classic FM to gain full control of the company, which operates classical music stations in the UK, Sweden, Holland and Finland. At the same time, EMI had expressed an interest in becoming a shareholder in Classic FM.

Celtas Cortos Conquer Brittany

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - After years of promoting Spanish folk rockers Celtas Cortos abroad, Warner Music Spain has finally found solid ground in Brittany, where the lively collective from Valladolid has been touring successfully. In fact, the group seem to be profiting from a growing interest in Celtic music, which has swept the whole of France. A nationwide tour of the country is scheduled for this Autumn.

East West France product manager Florence Pham is optimistic about the project, due to the current Celtic trend and Celtas Cortos' strong live shows. "The French are always eager to discover new music," she observes.

Dutch Music Industry Faces Cartel Allegation

AMSTERDAM - The Dutch record industry is being investigated for the second time in three years over allegations that it is running an illegal price-fixing cartel.

Though the previous enquiry by the Department of Commerce's Economic Control Unit found no evidence of such practices, the record business feels that this new investigation will

simply add to public prejudices over music pricing. However, the labels are adamant that, as before, no price-fixing is taking place.

The new Dutch investigation is the third faced by the record industry in the EU in as many years, and also follows renewed government interest in the price of music in Australia.

The first Dutch investigation was precipitated by, and exactly mirrored, an enquiry in the UK by the




Oasis Unplugged: What's The Story?

Between The Lines

Last week I had the rare pleasure of being invited to watch the UK's biggest band in action when Oasis performed live for "MTV Unplugged." A packed Royal Festival Hall waited in eager anticipation for the band to come on stage. It was therefore a bit of a disappointment when the band appeared without singer Liam Gallagher. "Liam has a sore throat," was the official line from brother Noel, who went on to take command of the vocal parts. He coped well under the circumstances, but Oasis without Liam is like watching Baywatch without Pamela Lee Anderson, as audiences in the US will no doubt be discovering. The strangest thing was, however, that Liam watched the whole show from a balcony.

Although the audience clapped and cheered, the enthusiasm was somewhat muted, and after one hour and 13 songs everything was over and done with. For some reason the "Unplugged" thing doesn't do Oasis many favours. Noel isn't particularly apt on acoustic guitar—his chord sequences are very basic and there isn't much vocal harmonizing, making his compositions rather one-dimensional. The thought often went through my head, "Are they really that exciting? What's all this fuss about?" I do know they can be very captivating live, but please keep those guitars plugged in!

MTV Europe, who found out about Liam's absence at the last minute, weren't particularly happy either. After statement from Creation ("...Liam is disappointed not to be able to perform for the fans but had the rare opportunity to see how brilliant Oasis are live..."), MTV addressed the assembled journalists with the line, "We're disappointed. It might be reshot."

However, proof of Oasis' unrivaled popularity was the view of many journalists comparing notes on the exact set list. For future biographers (will the new Mark Lewisohn stand up?) here's what the band played on August 23 1996: *Hello*; *Some Might Say*; *Live Forever*; a brand new song in A sharp (what else?), possibly called *One Fine Day*; *The Masterplan* (from the *Wonderwall* single); *Don't Look Back In Anger*; *Talk Tonight* (B-side of *Some Might Say*); *Morning Glory*; *Round Are Way* (also on *Wonderwall*); *Cast No Shadow*; *Whatever*; *Wonderwall* and a repeat of *Hello*.

Kiss Dance In The Streets

London's dance station Kiss 100 FM once again enjoyed a high profile at the world-famous Notting Hill Carnival on August 25 and 26. The station's own stage featured live performances by Jamiroquai, Chaka Demus & Pliers, Luciano, Raw Stylus and the Jungle Brothers. MD Gordon McNamee says, "Kiss 100 has been a part of Carnival for the last seven years, and it's something we really treasure as a special event. Our live acts and DJs always attract the biggest crowd and the atmosphere is wicked."

Five-Year IFPI Data Released

Record industry trade body IFPI has released the 1996 edition of *The Recording Industry In Numbers*, covering music market data from 1991-95. World music sales

reached an all-time high in 1995 at 3.8 billion units with a value of almost US\$40 billion—a substantial growth of 20% in volume and over 30% in value since 1991. As the table below shows, the industry has been transformed from a cassette to a CD-dominated market. The CD is now the world's leading music format and unit sales (at 2 billion in 1995) have far outstripped the peaks previously reached by both the LP (at around 1.1 billion units in 1981) and the cassette (1.5 billion in 1992). Vinyl sales are negligible, accounting for no more than 1% of worldwide sales, while singles sales are beginning to recover after a decade of decline.

Radio Dimensione Suono Launches In Romania

ROME - Italy's second largest commercial radio group, the Rome-based Radio Dimensione Suono (RDS) group, is to launch its first foreign radio venture in Romania later this month.

RDS President Eduardo Montefusco signed a deal earlier this year with Romania's largest industrial group Valentin to take a 30% stake in the country's first national commercial radio network (Music & Media, March 16), and to supply the technical, programming and marketing know-how.

Montefusco says that the new Romanian network (which

will also be known as Radio Dimensione Suono) has begun testing and will commence full programming by the end of September. "The format will be based on our Italian network formula of established hit music and news."

The extensive business interests of the Valentin Group, which include an airline and virtual monopolies in many manufacturing and service sectors in Romania, make the company the ideal strategic partner for RDS.

The Valentin Group is 98% owned by the controversial figure of George Paunescu, who at a recent press conference countered criticism of his business success in Romania. "I am neither head of the mafia, nor did I find [ex-Romanian President] Ceausescu's hidden treasure," he said. "Apart from shoe-making, textiles and the cement business, my companies control most of the business opportunities [in Romania], and we have no competitors. In five years I have built up a company employing myself and a lawyer

to a concern employing 76,000 people with a turnover in excess of \$900 million."

Meanwhile in Italy, RDS president Montefusco has not denied recent rumours that he is planning to expand the company's Italian radio holdings. Insiders claim that he has been negotiating to acquire Radio Montecarlo, which recently broke off negotiations with the French RMC Group over the issue of debt repayments (Music & Media, July 27). "We are interested in exploring all expansion opportunities," Montefusco confirms.

Larue Departs As Nostalgie Reshuffles

PARIS - Fabrice Larue, who has been general manager of Radio Nostalgie since 1991, has surprisingly quit the national ACE net.

The move comes as a surprise, as the station was in a good financial shape and recent ratings figures showed it had increased its audience to 5.2% of the French radio market.

The announcement of Larue's departure was made by Georges Vanderchmitt, president of both Nostalgie and its main shareholder, Sofrad. Both sides say the departure is amicable and that it was a joint decision.

Vanderchmitt says Larue has "fulfilled his mission" of turning Nostalgie into a profitable operation.

In 1995, Nostalgie's revenues reached Ffr330 million (app.US\$ 63 million) with pre-tax profits of Ffr90 million. These figures were up respectively from Ffr50 million in 1994 and losses of Ffr 10 million in 1991. Meanwhile the

audience has jumped from 1.5 million listeners in 1991 to 2.4 million last April, according to ratings body Mediamétrie.

French press reports suggest that Larue, 38, could well head a group of investors which will bid for the RMC group if the government relaunches the privatisation process which failed earlier this year. RMC owns full-service station RMC, 51% of Nostalgie, oldies net Montmartre FM and sales house GEM.

Replacing Larue at Nostalgie is the station's financial director Henry Laurent, who also becomes general manager of Nostalgie International, the station's affiliate which handles the company's foreign operations (84 stations in 14 countries).

Meanwhile, Georges Bermejo is promoted to deputy general manager, and Frédéric Coste has been promoted to deputy general manager, in charge of international development. Roger Coste moves up from sales director to general manager of sales house GEM.

UNITED KINGDOM

Rich Plans Are Scrapped

Plans for The Tony Rich Project's second single *Like A Woman* (LaFace/Arista Records) to be released in a two-CD set for the UK market have been scrapped. The original idea was to include as bonus tracks exclusive live recordings of the single and its predecessor *Nobody Knows*. The tracks were recorded from sessions on Radio 3FM in Holland and on BBC TV's "Later With Jools Holland". According to an Arista spokesperson, Rich decided that he'd prefer people to "come and see the live performance for themselves rather than hear the live recordings first, and they'll get the chance to do that before Christmas." The single will still include a previously unreleased track called *Highway*, taken from the soundtrack to the forthcoming Laurence Fishburne film "Fled".

Singles Market Up 11%

BPI figures reveal that trade deliveries for the second quarter slowed to a rise of under 2%, most of which was down to an 11% rise in the value of the singles market. The artists most responsible for the singles growth were The Fugees, Baddiel/Skinner/Lightning Seeds, Gina G, Mark Morrison and George Michael. Alanis Morissette, George Michael and Take That earned the biggest slice of the albums gain. A look at the long term picture reveals just how significant Oasis are. (*What's The Story*) *Morning Glory?* has now been certified ten times platinum. Only six albums have ever sold better in the UK, and none of them have managed such figures in only ten months. They are The Beatles *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band*, Michael Jackson's *Bad* and *Thriller*, Dire Straits' *Brothers In Arms*, Simply Red's *Stars* and Queen's *Greatest Hits, Volume 1*.

FRANCE

Changes At Radio France

Michel Boyon, president of public broadcasting corporation Radio France, has made two key appointments at the head of the group. Gilbert Denoyan, previously in charge of synergies and strategy, has been promoted to the post of deputy general manager, overseeing scheduling, coordination and development. But he

will not have power over the day-to-day management of the different Radio France stations (France Info, France Inter, France Culture and France Musique). Replacing Anne Coutard (who left the corporation), Boyon has appointed civil servant François-Didier Lemoine as deputy general manager of management and production. Boyon has decided not to replace Radio France general manager Patrice Duhamel. Boyon said that the position will not be filled, and that he will assume Duhamel's duties.

GERMANY

East West To Release AIDS Album

Hamburg-based East West records has joined up with German AIDS organisation Big Spender for a campaign to promote AIDS awareness. The campaign will include the release of an album *America Is Dying Slowly* (abbreviated as AIDS), the launch of an information help-line and several information spots for broadcast on radio and TV. The 16-track album contains new material from US hip hop artists such as De La Soul, Coolio, Wu-Tang Clan and Mobb Deep. More information is available on <http://www.netville.de/eastwest>.

ITALY

Costella Goes Back And Forth

Ex-Classic 105 MD Gianluca Costella has returned to the studio with a daily show on Italy's national dance station Italia Network. Costella last year closed down gold formatted Classic 105 when, together with his partner Alberto Hazan, he sold his stake to national music syndicator Radio Italia SMI. Costella says of his new daily 12:00-14:00 show ("Back & Forth"), "It's a crossover programme bridging the transition between Italia Network's general EHR morning programmes and the up-front afternoon specialist dance shows. The idea was inspired by US urban-crossover networks operating a similar format." The show alternates current dance and R&B releases with dance classics from the late '70s and '80s. Costella also juxtaposes new releases which feature samples with the original source record, drawing on his extensive personal collection of over 16,000 records.

Rix Stations Face Fines

STOCKHOLM - The Swedish Broadcasting Commission has threatened 10 stations belonging to the national ACE network Radio Rix with heavy fines for not producing enough local content in their programming.

The Commission has posted fines of 100,000 SEK (approx. US\$15,000) on each of the stations, which are part of the huge Kinnevik media empire. The ruling is based on Swedish broadcasting laws which require

networked stations to produce at least one-third of their daily output locally.

The networks have been quick to discover what is the cheapest method of producing those local hours. "For many stations, it means having a CD-player or hard disk unit at each location. And we've had to reluctantly accept that such a tactic follows the letter of the law," admits Eva Tetzell, senior advisor with responsibility for local radio at the Broadcasting Commission.

Rix, however, had tried a different tactic. "They were just playing music from a central playlist, and they tried to argue that it was local because every station had made the decision to use that playlist. We weren't prepared to accept that," she says.

In terms of scope, the judgement is second only to a similar case affecting the entire NRJ network in March, which also centred around the "localness" of output. Henrik Damm, managing director of Radio Rix, says that although he disagreed with the Commission's verdict, he is forced to accept it. "It's not clear what changes we will make," she says. "However, it will certainly involve greater technical investment."

A new law in December is set to give the Broadcasting Commission greater powers, allowing it to levy fines without recourse to the courts. The fines will be limited to a maximum of 10 percent of the station's annual turnover. Whether that will induce more stations to meet their legal requirements remains unclear. "There are about 87 stations in Sweden," says Eva Tetzell. "We just don't have the time to check them all."

Storm Over Danish Disco Spoof

COPENHAGEN - Performing rights organisation KODA has banned radio airplay of *Margarine* by tongue-in-cheek cover band Diskofil.

The Danish pronunciation of *Margarine* is nearly identical to *Macarena*, this summer's smash dance hit by Los Del Rio. KODA has notified radio stations that the Spanish duo who penned the original—Romero and Ruizhad—had not approved the Danish parody, written by Morten Madsen and Flemming Nielsen. "Margarine" is a track from Diskofil's second CD, *Dansant*, which will be in stores on September 3.

Diskofil, who have become biggest selling act in the Danish singles chart so far in 1996, were recently presented with a gold/platinum disc in recognition of sales of 50,000 units of its debut album *Plagiat* (see picture).

The group's name can be loosely translated as "discophile" or "disco lover," and the title of the debut album means "Plagiarism." Both the group's name and the album title aptly describe the nature of the band, who twist lyrics

with puns that fit the disco beat.

"Diskofil love disco music, and want to bring it back into the '90s in a big way," says Scandinavian Records promotions manager Pernille Kaarde. "They play a little bit on sex, and have fun with the lyrics."

A forthcoming single will play on Kylie Minogue's *I*

Should Be So Lucky, with Diskofil singing (in Danish) "I Only Wear Sloggi" (a brand of ladies undergarments). The male/female band, whose members include the likes of "Porno Bent" and "Disco Lydia," has been drawing full houses in Denmark with costumes that give a wink to unusual sexual tastes, but are so ludicrous they do not offend.





Geneva Radioscape French Driven

■ CITY PROFILE



Despite its status as a key European city, Geneva plays a relatively minor role in the Swiss radio market. Only 420,000 citizens (7% of the Swiss population over 15) live in the state (or "kanton") which surrounds the famous Lake Geneva at Switzerland's south-western tip.

"Switzerland's main radio markets are Zurich, Bern and Basle," says Felix Kilchsperger, sales director of the Zurich-based sales house Radio Tele. "The radio advertising market in the French-speaking parts of Switzerland is rather small compared to the German-speaking areas."

Swiss stations compete with French broadcasters, whose signals reach across the border, for the ears of Geneva's population. Official Swiss ratings for 1994-'95 (supplied by Publica Data) show that French stations are very successful. Publica Data will publish the 1995-'96 ratings later this month, but managing director Rolf Müller believes that the French operators—particularly Nostalgie—have improved their position further during the past year. Radio Lac programme director Jackie Sanders agrees, and names La Premiere, NRJ and Nostalgie as the current Top 3 stations in Geneva. And according to Radio Tele's Kilchsperger, his organisation frequently sells advertising time on French border stations to Swiss advertisers.

From ACE To EHR

Radio Lac is the most successful Swiss commercial broadcaster in Geneva. Launched in June 1986, the station quickly established itself, with its soft ACE format targeting Geneva's 30-40 year olds. Ten years later, however, Lac pumps out an up-tempo EHR format. "The soft ACE format died in 1993," declares Sanders. "Couleur 3 and NRJ burst onto the Geneva market and upped the pace. Music, jingles and presentation have become more aggressive since then." Both stations proved extremely popular, so Lac decided to change format and join the race.

After three years, programme intensity and pace have reached a peak. Now

the key objective in Geneva is to play the latest hits before somebody else does. "Novelty is the decisive factor," says Sanders, "at least 60% of the songs we play are brand new. You have to play songs long before they are actually released in Switzerland!"

Ahead Of The Game

Radio Lac keeps ahead of the Swiss release schedules with the help of Paris-based programme supplier Music In Europe. "We receive bi-weekly preview compilations of new releases from the UK and the US on CD," reveals Sanders. He also uses CD compilations from Euro Exclusive and Vanguard on a regular basis. "We were playing Eric Clapton's new single *Change The World* for three weeks before Warner Music Switzerland plugged us with the single."

However, the arrival of two more stations in Geneva is set to cause Lac to change its format again. The Swiss ministry for transport, communication and energy handed out local licences to World Radio Geneva (WRG) and One FM last October, and both stations officially went on air in June. Sanders is not worried about WRG (which targets English speaking expatriates), but One FM turned out to be a nasty surprise for his station. "Initially we assumed that they would go for a very young audi-


ence with a techno and dance-based format," he explains. "But from what I hear they sound almost identical to Lac."

Clouds On Horizon

Sanders sees a serious problem on the horizon. "Listeners do not stay tuned to one station anymore, but pick a programme that suits their mood." Today's radio, he argues, fulfills the function of the old-fashioned juke box—so to motivate listeners to select your station you need a distinctive identity. "As soon as a second station with a similar format comes along, you need to change."

Lac plans to introduce a new format in September. Sanders reveals that new releases will continue to play an important role in the format. However, he does not want to commit himself to a specific music genre just yet. "I love dance music, but we would be crazy to try this format in Geneva. A niche format works best in areas of high urban concentration, like Paris or London. In Geneva we could not round up enough dance fans to make the venture commercially viable."

Sanders used a recent holiday in Italy to collect inspiration for Lac's new format. "For years I listened to Radio 101, but now it has changed completely and sounds quite



dull. Radio 105 in Milan, on the other hand, is a really interesting station."

World Radio Geneva (WRG) avoids the French competition altogether, targeting English-speaking expatriates lured to Geneva by its strong financial services industry. WRG's PR director Brandeis Hall estimates that an additional two million English-speaking business travellers visit the city every year, providing the station with a large captive audience.


Contrary to the original concept of a business station with music, WRG is now a music station with a limited amount of business news. The station adapted its format after the results of market research conducted by the Hamburg office of US company Coleman Research. "People still seem to listen to the radio for the music," concludes Hall.

At present, WRG is broadcasting a temporary summer schedule containing mainly light ACE music. "We have been jamming the frequency with non-stop music since April, to prevent it from being squat-

ted," says Hall. Listeners who have found the station by accident are apparently staying tuned, as word of the new music channel gets around.

After its re-launch on September 20, WRG will aim at a core target group of 25-55 year olds. Hall describes the station's format as "radio for grown ups"—soft ACE with 50% music and 50% speech.

Despite Hall's enthusiasm, Radio Tele's Kilchsperger sees little potential for English language advertising in Geneva. "Swiss radio ads are usually produced in German and French," he explains, arguing that there is little incentive for Swiss advertisers to spend extra money on English-lan-

guage commercials.

But Hall is confident that, in the long run, the expatriate market will attract advertisers because of its spending power. According to Hall, jewellery and watch manufacturer Beaume & Mercier, English language newspaper *International Herald Tribune* and local retailers are among WRG's first advertising clients. Whether WRG can claim its niche outside the rat race of the French language stations remains to be seen. Hall expects first preliminary ratings for the station in January 1997.



Celtas Cortos Ride Celtic Wave In Brittany

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - Spanish folk rockers Celtas Cortos have been actively pursuing crossborder success with their mix of Celtic melodies and rock rhythms. Now that France is experiencing a modest revival of Celtic music—Britton Dan Ar Braz represented France at the Eurovision Song Contest this year—Celtas Cortos find themselves playing for their Gallic cousins more often.

The French release of the latest Celtas Cortos album for DRO/East West *En Estos Días Inciertos* (In these Uncertain Times), which offers the added ingredient of latin influence couldn't come at a better time. East West France product manager Florence Pham is happy with the current French fascination for all things Celtic. "The French are always eager to discover new music," comments Pham. "A couple of years ago it was world music, but recently Celtic music and the rediscovery of old instruments has been coinciding with the emergence of new age ideas."

Nationwide Tour

A short tour of Brittany was organized by Dan Ar Braz' promotor Jacques Abalia, who is specialised in Celtic music. It proved very successful, resulting in a bigger, nationwide tour of France. As Pham explains, "Word got around after each show, because they are so good on stage. They play an exotic form of Celtic music, but it's

credible. It's not an artificially put together product."

On their Spanish homefront Celtas Cortos are already platinum (100,000 copies) after 14 weeks. Warner Music

international exploitation manager Yann Barbot expects to quadruple that amount. One of the band's biggest strengths is their energetic live presence, which is enhanced by impressive art work and acrobats who act out the lyrics. "They tend to sell around 400,000 copies—the previous albums *Tranquilo Majete* and *Cuentame Un Cuento* have done that well. They are famous in the live circuit, only this summer they've played 100 shows." Barbot has no immediate plans for Germany, a market where Celtas Cortos made some noise with their *Vamos!* album.

"We're looking for a new concert promotor in Germany and until then, it doesn't make sense to work that market. The Spanish and French marketing plans are enough for the moment."

Barbot and Eduardo Pérez of the band's Alacran management have long-term plans to conquer the Spanish rock market in Puerto Rico and the US. "There is a big interest from WEA Miami, but we'll have to be patient," says Barbot. Pérez adds that, "At the moment, we're very happy with our success in France. Hopefully Warner Spain will help introduce us in other territories. I am daydreaming about a US college tour, but we

still need to discuss it."

Explorations

En Estos Días Inciertos is a step away from the fun-loving, rock stompers à la the Pogues, (or rather "Los Pokes" as they are known in Spain). The compositions are more diverse, allowing for latin rhythms, ska beats and jazzy explorations. While gearing up for the band's open air show in Santiago de Compostela, bass player Oscar García explains that, "One of the tracks in which you can see the transition is *Emigrante*, which has a

more latin sound. It was written by our singer Jesus Cifuentes." Drummer Nacho Castro adds that, "We like to play around with latin and other Brazilian rhythms, because it's in our blood." Nevertheless, Celtas Cortos remain faithful, to their Celtic music influences.

"It has an enormous wealth of rhythms and melodies. You can take them and change them around according to your own wishes," says Oscar. The best example of this creative mixing is album track *Irlandalusi*. As Nacho explains, "We are also passionate about flamenco—sometimes a flamenco guitarist plays with us—and we wanted to do something with him. *Irlandalusi* blends the Arab elements of flamenco with Celtic music."

Live Circuit

For Yann Barbot, the biggest challenge is radio. "If you do something different with your music, you have a problem with radio, not only in Spain. So we are going to concentrate on radio more heavily in the near future. There is a strong comeback of latin music, Gloria Estefan, Rosana Arbelo and Luis Miguel are doing extremely well. So that might help us."

Ophélie Winter Pushes For Autumn Impact

PARIS - The French tabloids started snooping around the personal life of 22-year old Ophélie Winter when her album *No Soucy!* (East West) was released last May. But there is more to the blonde artist than a juicy family history writes Thessa Mooij. Her funky R&B compositions and her convincing vocals brought the album and its two singles gold status, while Warner has made her an international priority.

Much of the media attention for the model/actress/singer/songwriter is focused on the fact that her father, David-Alexandre Winter, himself a singer, walked out on his family when she was two years old. But unlike other ambitious models, Winter

has a considerable talent for writing US influenced R&B tracks together with her brother Michael. She has such close ties to the US urban artists scene, that she even cornered Coolio to contribute his *Keep It On The Red Light* to the album.

The global buzz around Winter is certainly keeping East West France international exploitation manager Estelle Cohen busy. The English album version *Soon* was released in Europe on August 30. Winter will spend most of September and October doing promotion in Sweden, Italy, Germany, Switzerland and possibly the UK. The first international single will be *Living In Me*. "We expecting to reach at least top 10 positions with it," says Cohen. "Each market will have its own strategy, but the bottom line is to reach the top of the European charts. We're think it can really break in Germany. Also, Italy has so many TV shows she can become a big star there. Radio NRJ in Sweden is so enthusiastic about her they are even playing the French single *Dieu M'A Donn e La Foi*."





Eurochart analysis by Pieter Kops



Zucchero

Unlike albums from Anglo-American artists that often enjoy a pan-European simultaneous release and a subsequent high debut in the Top 100, Continental European artists usually have to do the European chart game step by step. One perfect example of an artist who has managed to take in each European territory at his own pace, backed by substantial touring schedules, is **Zucchero Fornaciari** (Polydor). His current one-million selling 1995 album *Spirito DiVino* is presently in its third chart run after having left the chart on two separate occasions. It's happening again with the artist's *Il Volo* single, now for the fifth time in Border Breakers (see page 18).

To top these impressive achievements, this week Zucchero's album is awarded the Sales Breaker designation, due to a big jump in the French sales chart (from number 17 to 4) and

continued top 30 positions in Belgium, Germany, Switzerland and home market Italy.

More continental European million-selling music comes courtesy of **Pur** (Intercord). While still firmly entrenched in the European Top 100 at number 91 with their IFPI Europe one-million certified *Abenteuerland*, the German pop rockers now enter the chart at number 11 with their follow-up and second live album, *Live - Die Zweite*. The album is a resounding success in Germany where it entered directly at number 1.

On the singles side, **George Michael** (Virgin) has entered at number 8 with *Spinning The Wheel*, the third single to be taken from *Older* (currently charting at number 4 in the European Top 100 with a double Platinum mark by its side). The single's

chart debut is due to new entries in the top 30's of Ireland, Finland and Switzerland, the top 100 of Germany and a big leap in the UK (to number 2).

Spinning The Wheel marks Michael's 10th hit on the Eurochart Hot 100 during this decade. In the box is a complete, chronological list of the artist's Eurochart hits of the '90s, each title followed by its peak position and the year of chart entrance.

EMI Buys Into Radio

The new enlarged GWR company was finally formed through a deal in which EMI purchased Time Warner's Classic FM shares, selling them on to GWR at the same price in exchange for new GWR shares.

In order to comply with UK ownership restrictions, GWR is selling 80% of its shareholdings in Leicester Sound FM and 11% of its stake in London News Radio to The Daily Mail Group (which is also a leading shareholder in GWR). However, GWR will have to make further reductions in its UK radio interests if it is to stay within the 15% total radio market ownership ceiling set by the Radio Authority.

Despite the success of Classic FM in the UK (where it launched in 1992 as the country's first national commercial station), the Classic FM Group reported pre-tax losses of £2.8 million (app. US\$4.2 million) in the year ending November 30 1995, largely because of heavy losses incurred by its non-UK operations.

GWR press spokesman Matthew Smallwood says GWR's management team "has an exceptionally good track record in turning round this sort of company," and cites the strong financial recovery of the Chiltern Radio Group, acquired by GWR in a £19 million (app. US\$ 28.5 million) hostile takeover last year.

According to a press statement from GWR's bankers Hambros, GWR hopes to "grow

Classic FM's revenues strongly and achieve operating margins more in line with the industry norm." Significant cost savings are predicted through "sharing resources in the financial, programming and research areas."

Specific plans include: promotion and marketing of the Classic FM regional rate card, whereby advertisers can buy advertising to be broadcast by Classic FM on a regional, rather than national, basis; and the creation of a London-based GWR sales team alongside Classic FM's existing sales operation, specifically to generate increased direct sales to national advertisers.

GWR's chief executive Ralph Bernard has been appointed chief executive of Classic FM, succeeding John Spearman, who becomes deputy chairman of Classic.

British government's Monopolies and Mergers Commission. Its report, published in the spring of 1994, gave the UK labels a clean bill of health.

A spokesman for Holland's Economic Control Unit confirms, "At the moment, we are investigating whether prices are being fixed in the CD business. However, we never reveal anything before the matter is resolved."

Such uncertainty is regarded as damaging by the Dutch record business. Paul Solleveld, managing director of Dutch IFPI body NVPI comments, "They only disclose the bad news, if there is any. If they don't find anything as was the case three years ago, they don't mention it at all. Therefore they never take away the bad reputation our industry gets from their investigations."

The new investigation was allegedly precipitated by a letter from Dutch-based independent Arcade Music Company to a retailer. The letter, which was presented to the competition authorities, is reported to have mentioned price-fixing. Solleveld strongly denies this.

"The content of the letter was about recommended retail price, which is not the same as

a fixed price," he states.

Solleveld's initial impression that the enquiry would be centered on retail practices was shattered on August 27 when investigators arrived at Arcade's offices to inspect its business records and documentation. Arcade's Dutch managing director and group president/CEO Andre de Raaff praises the inspectors for the way they conducted themselves while on his premises, but declares that this company has nothing to hide.

"We release CDs in various price categories," he says. "Besides, there are even differences between the full-price CDs we bring out and the ones other companies do. So who's talking about price-fixing?"

Solleveld and De Raaff echo an argument that was made repeatedly during the UK investigation that retailers are responsible for retail prices.

Solleveld argues that Dutch dealers take a higher margin than those in neighbouring Germany, and De Raaff comments, "The retailers determine the margin, not us. That's good for them, and I don't blame them for doing so."

Rumoured This Week...

RDS Head Hunting in Milan

Rome-based EHR network Radio Dimensione Suono (RDS) is planning to open a Milan studio, and is reported to be head hunting a major on-air talent to broadcast a daily programme from the city. OTR hears that Radio Deejay's top-rated afternoon jock Amadeus is one name being considered by the station.

More Changes At Capital Gold?

Following the recruitment of stand-up comic Mike Osman (Music & Media, August 10) OTR hears that further programming changes could be in the air at London's 1548 AM Capital Gold. These are thought to centre around 95.8 Capital FM lunchtime presenter Mick Brown making the switch to Gold. Key 103/Manchester jock Steve Penk, who joins Capital Radio next year, is allegedly being lined up for the Capital FM mid-morning slot currently occupied by Pat Sharp, who it is understood will retain a daytime slot on the FM service.

BMG Forms Benelux Company; Jolink Leaves

OTR hears that Derk Jolink, managing director of BMG Belgium since 1991, has left the company. The move is understood to be related to BMG forming a merged Benelux company headed by Doris Sturm, the current head of BMG Netherlands.

Radio Veteran Soer Leaves Arcade

Although it happened a few weeks ago, OTR only recently discovered that Jeroen Soer is leaving his post as president of the Arcade Media Group (where were those press releases, Arcade?). Having worked for pubcasters KRO, VARA and TROS, Soer founded Radio 10 in 1987, which was acquired by Arcade in 1990. At the Arcade Media Group, Soer was responsible for Radio 10 Gold, Concert Radio, Love Radio and the TV stations TV10 and The Music Factory. His move is unrelated to the recent acquisition of Arcade by Dutch publishing house Wegener, says Soer. Frustrated by the ongoing protection policies of the Dutch government towards its public broadcasters, Soer is apparently ready for some new challenges.

VH-1 Programmer To Leave

OTR hears gossip that VH-1 Germany's programme director, Volker Praekelt, will be leaving the station. Is Volker Kramarz a good replacement candidate?

Musik Woche Ready To Break Borders

Are the rumours true that German trade magazine *Musik Woche* wants to start up a pan-European publication? There are plans, so we understand, to publish an English version of the magazine, blending major news from the German market with some news from other European territories.

PPL To Clamp Down On Phones?

Phonographic Performance Ltd is thought to be considering a copyright clampdown on the users of telephone systems which play recorded music while callers are kept on hold. PPL estimates that only 20% of over 25,000 UK companies using such systems have the required authorisation. With licence fees starting at £79 (app. US\$118), the potential revenues are significant.

Airplay Action

EHR Top 40 commentary by Pieter Kops

This week, European Hit Radio welcomes the trademark '70s-influenced, Stevie Wonder-style funk pop sound to which **Jamiroquai** treats us on its new single *Virtual Insanity*. It is the opening track and lead-off single from the new Jamiroquai set, the 13-track *Travelling Without Moving*, the band's third album and the follow up to *The Return Of The Space Cowboy* (1994). The latter spent 17 weeks in the European Top 100 Albums with a peak at number 8. Grabbing the highest new entry in the EHR Top 40 at number 29, the new single marks the third hit on Europe's leading radio format for the UK act, following the 1993 *Blow Your Mind* (peaking at number 33) and the 1994 *Space Cowboy* (28).

Virtual Insanity starts with a 39-station roster, encompassing eight countries. Of these, the UK, Norway, Poland and Italy stand out as most supportive, producing national penetration ratios of 42-63%. On a regional level, the track also charts in the Top 20's of Italy (at number 12), the UK (15) and Poland (14) (see Major Market Airplay, page 19).

Also entering this week is **Sting's** *I Was Brought To My Senses*, the third single from *Mercury Falling*. Debuting at number 36, it is the 13th EHR hit for Sting since the inception of the chart in December 1990, including the artist's collaborations with Eric Clapton, Bryan Adams, Rod Stewart and Pato Banton. The UK rock star hit the format's number 1 position four times in the past six years—with *All This Time* (1991, four weeks

at the top), *If I Ever Lose My Faith In You* (1993, three weeks), *All For Love* (1994, with Bryan Adams and Rod Stewart, seven weeks) and *Let Your Soul Be Your Pilot* (1996, three weeks).

The jazzy *I Was Brought To My Senses* has been put on rotation by 45 EHR stations in 10 countries. As yet, Poland leads the list with a 65% penetration level, followed by the UK (44%), Switzerland (44%), Italy (42%) and Norway (40%).

Meanwhile, **Pet Shop Boys** earns the Radio Active award with *Se A Vida É (That's The Way Life Is)*. The single leaps up five places during its fifth charting week, landing at number 3 with a 93-station roster by its side, including 30 new adds—the highest number of the week. This roster is spread out over 22 countries, with the UK, Ireland, Denmark, Switzerland and Poland standing out as most supportive (65-100% penetration in those territories). This week's increase is mainly due to new airplay in Poland, Germany and Holland.



On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Raúl Cairo



Los Del Rio

As predicted last week, the members of **Los Del Rio** can open their bottles of Cava (Spanish champagne) as they are now the sole Border Breakers champion. *Macarena* is now enjoying its 12th week on top of the chart (a new record) and although both **Eros Ramazzotti's** *Stella Gemella* and **Robert Miles' Fable** are steadily gaining momentum, the gap between them and Los Del Rio remains considerable.

The winner of this week's Road Runner award is **Zucchero**, whose *Il Volo* seems to last forever because as soon as it gets dropped in one market it gets added in another. This time around it's Holland, where the track, taken from last year's *Spirito DiVino* album is warmly embraced by EHR and ACE programmers alike. Leading EHR publishers such as NPS/Hilversum and TROS Radio 3/Hilversum are among those who have added it this week, while it continues to do well in numerous territories across Europe. Most notable is its massive success in Germany, where the English-language version (*My Love*) helped pave the way for the Italian-language original later on. Faithful readers of this column may recall Music & Media's July 6 issue, where this track entered the chart for the fifth time, having debuted on December 16, 1995.

This week's highest entry is **J.J. Cale's** *Guitar Man*, apparently a track a host of programmers in Poland were waiting for. The song is the titletrack of his album, released earlier this year by Virgin France's rock imprint Delabel (hence its appearance in the Border Breakers chart). It proves to be a worthy successor to the first single *As Days Go By*, which peaked at position number 17 (a tie coincidentally) in M&M's May 11 issue. Poland and Spain were, and still are the markets where this veteran singer-songwriter has earned most acceptance. Among the more steadfast backers are Polish national EHR network Polskie Radio 3/Warsaw and Spanish rock-flavoured EHR network Cadena 100/Madrid.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M aims to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.


