THE American that England made famous, Hildegarde, glimmering-eyed, singing clairvoyant, dancing, dancing, dancing—when Irving Berlin calls "the greatest actress and greatest of song in the profession today," is coming back after ten years to the city that first recognised her, and to earn dollars for Britain. She is arriving this month to record a series of programmes for Harry Alan Towers, which will be broadcast throughout the world.

Hildegard first came to Europe in 1933, an unknown American singer. She returned to America in 1936 and became a national celebrity. In those three crowded years she had made her name, and kept it company and the first of these will be held on October 1 at the Royal Albert Hall.
