THE Beatles are to be recorded by an independent disc company in future—even though they are still contracted to EMI! The though they are still contracted to EMI! The new organisation has been formed by four top recording men—George Martin, Ron Richards and John Burgess of EMI, and Peter Sullivan of Decca—and promises to be a powerful force in the British record industry. 
